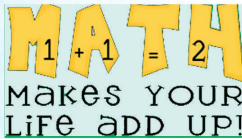
Engaging the Families

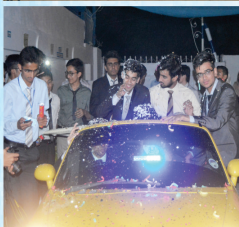


Celebrating Childhood

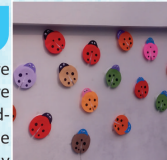
Love for Confectionary
